THE GOAL OF THE PROJECT IS TO INTRODUCE YOUNG PEOPLE STANDING ON THE THRESHOLD OF ADULT LIFE WITH ALL POSSIBLE SPHERES OF DECISION-MAKING AFFECTING ON THEIR LIVES THROUGH POLICIES SUCH AS MAKING DECISION AND ENTREPRENEURIAL SKILLS. THE QUESTION OF TAKING THE FIRST JOB BY YOUNG PEOPLE AFTER FINISHING THE EDUCATION HAS BECOME ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT THINGS OF THE EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM IN ENTIRE EUROPE AND EVEN THE WORLD.

MAIN PROJECT OBJECTIVES

EUROPEAN EDUCATIONAL SYSTEMS ARE FACING A COMMON ISSUE: THE PERSISTENT HIGH RATE OF YOUNGSTERS LEAVING SCHOOL BEFORE HAVING ACHIEVED A CERTIFICATION THAT HELPS THEM TO BE COMPETITIVE ON THE LABOUR MARKET.
